



Nouns and Adjectives: Singular and Plural

Note how these nouns change from singular to plural:

Singular	Plural
puella	puellae
servus	servī
puer	puerī
vir	virī

Study the following sentences, and note how the nouns and adjectives change from singular to plural:

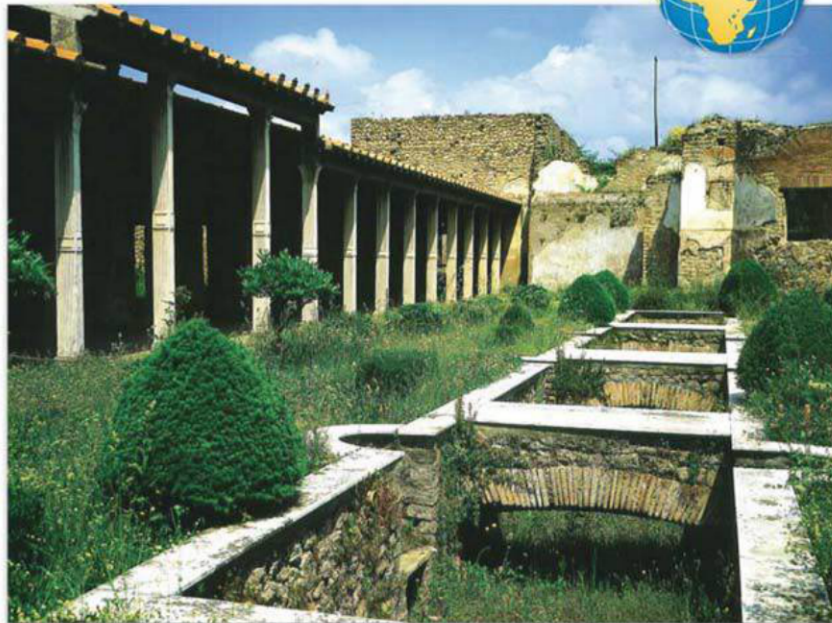
- Cornēlia est **puella Rōmāna**.
Cornēlia et Flāvia sunt **puellae Rōmānae**.
- Dāvus est **servus**.
Multī servī in agrīs labōrant.
- Mārcus est **puer Rōmānus**.
Mārcus et Sextus sunt **puerī Rōmānī**.
- Cornēlius est **vir Rōmānus**.
Virī Rōmānī in Italiā habitant.
